

Dark or blue, NHI will be implemented: President Ramaphosa

This morning in a launch of Thuma Mina Campaign in Tembisa, President Cyril Ramaphosa has assured the people that National Health Insurance (NHI) will be implemented, regardless of different views about it.

Ramaphosa engaged in a morning walk with other African National Congress (ANC) officials.

“I am here to once again assure you that the ANC government, will serve the people of South Africa with dedication. Firstly, we will continue to ensure that corruption is taken care of. No official who is corrupt will get away with it,” said Ramaphosa.

He said the most important thing is that, in their attempts to out root corruption, the people who are in charge of administration in Gauteng are in the same accord with them.

“I am happy that in our battle with corruption, our Premier David Makhura is with me, Dr Aaron Motsoaledi is with me also and we will surely win this battle in no time,” the President emphasized.

“Whether there are people opposing against it or not, we will implement the NHI and this will be done in no time,” Ramaphosa said

NHI is a financing system that will make sure that all citizens of South Africa and legal long-term residents are provided with essential healthcare, regardless of their employment status and ability to make a direct monetary contribution to the NHI Fund.
